A lengthy discussion of the Festival of Bands took place. Many pros and cons were presented as to continuing the concert beyond 2022. This year's concert is tentatively scheduled for Sept 25 at Northampton High School.

Jean Rohal updated us on The Bethlehem summer concert schedule. At the present time it looks like the concerts will be held.

Deb Heiney and Matt Cascioli reported on our meeting with Chris Hendricks regarding the Allentown Summer program. Active Life will again be used as a rain location. Payments are scheduled for June 15 and Sept 19 of this year.

A discussion of membership obligations took place and Cascioli passed out the list of members that have not yet paid 2022 membership dues. As of today, we have received payments from 449 musicians.

The resignations of Herb Payung, Geoff Schneider, Ron Porotsky and Henry Hoffman were accepted upon motion of Krasley and Danner.

The meeting adjourned at 10:30 A:M upon motion of Krasley and Williams.
