Bills in the amount of \$3,586.78 were ordered paid upon motion of Krasley and Richmond.

The treasurer's report was accepted upon motion of Seifert and Danner.

The Business Manager reported work dues collections for the month of May as 3,075.83 and for the year we are at \$15,946.81. Accepted upon motion of Krasley and Reisteter.

Reisteter reported that we have received 9 scholarship applications and the committee will meet during the month of June to determine the winners. The nominees will be presented to the board at the July meeting.

The following by-law change was accepted without dissent; Special accounts may be set up for collective bargaining units as requested by their orchestra/ensemble committees. A formal request must be submitted to the president and secretary treasurer.

Carol Yale was nominated to be the locals delegate to the National Convention by Danner and Krasley. Their being no other nominations Yale was elected by acclamation.

MPTF did not honor all of our 250th applications for the special funding for these events, upon motion of Seifert and Krasley the applications will be paid in full using funds from the locals yearly allocation.

President Yale gave an update of the NEP Negotiations.

A discussion of several of the IEB Recommendations to be voted on at the upcoming convention took place.

Don Kemmerer mentioned that in some cases applicants for membership under the age of 18 will have to fill out clearance forms.

The next meeting will be July 12th.
